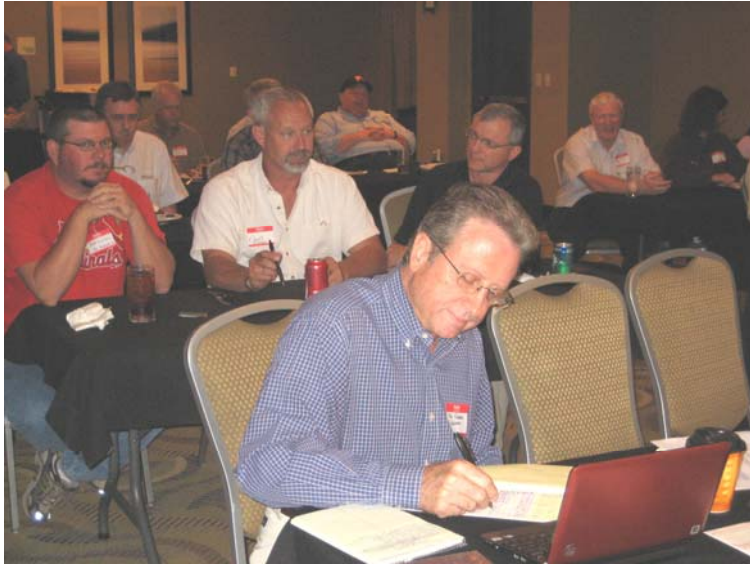
Our first meeting was held on September 22, 2011 at Holiday Inn&Suites in Stillwater, OK.
